**VICTORIAN CLASSIC AND VINTAGE SPEEDWAY CLUB INCORPORATED:**  
**CODE OF CONDUCT FOR DEMONSTRATION EVENTS.**

1. Participants and crew are to comply with the requirements of Speedway Australia Drug and Alcohol Policy
2. No open toe shoes permitted in pit area or track infield.
3. No smoking shall be allowed in the pits.
4. Prior to demonstrations at any venue, the Promoter and Chief Steward shall be issued with a copy of this Code of Conduct to acquaint themselves with the operating procedures and regulations.
5. **Racing is not permitted.** Safety must be of prime concern to everyone. There will be no prizes for finishing positions.
6. **Speed to be at the drivers discretion**, relying on his / her ability, the characteristics of the vehicle, the track conditions, most of all his / her sense of responsibility and safety to others. Please be aware the throttle pedal works both ways.
7. Slower vehicles are to stay on the pole line where possible, and faster vehicles are to pass on outside, and only when there is sufficient room and it is safe to do so
8. A blue flag must be displayed to a slower driver as faster drivers approach, which means he / she should maintain position on track, and where necessary, **gradually** move to the pole line.
9. If a slow vehicle continues to ride the fence, then the faster vehicle may pass on the inside, without aggression to the other driver and only if there is sufficient space to allow for error.
10. Failure to obey the above rules will lead to a caution being issued by the Chief Steward. Any recurrence of an original caution and the driver may be excluded from further participation in the event by the chief steward.
11. Promoters and track officials will be informed that the chequered flag will be used to indicate the end of the demonstration.
12. Commentators will be advised that times and positions of finishing are not to be given, and the events not to be called a race, but are demonstrations.
